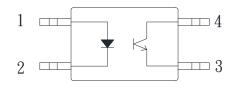


4PIN LSOP PHOTOTRANSISTOR PHOTOCOUPLER

Description

The KT101X series consist of an infrared emitting diode, optically coupled to a phototransistor detector, and is incorporated in a 4 pin LSOP wide body package. It features a high current transfer ratio, low coupling capacitance and high isolation voltage.

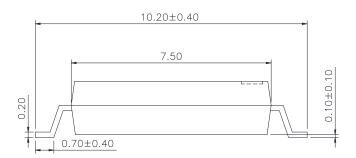

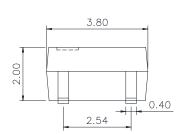

Fig.2 Collector Power Dissipation vs. Ambient Temperature

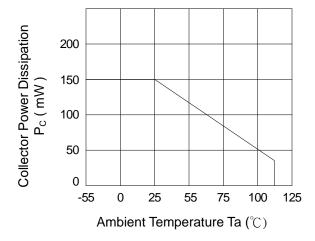


Fig.4 Forward Current vs. Ambient Temperature

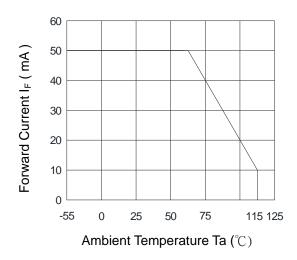


Fig.1 Current Transfer Ratio vs. Forward Current

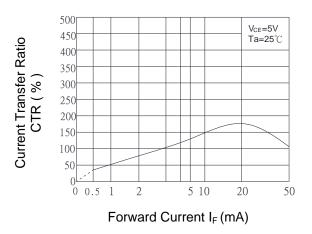


Fig.3 Collector Dark Current

vs. Ambient Temperature

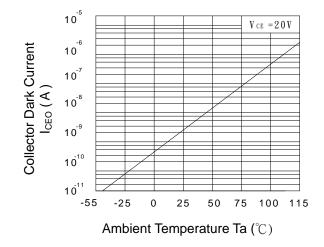
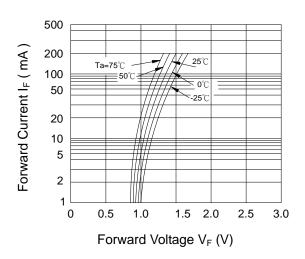


Fig.5 Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage

Fig.6 Collector Current vs. Collector-Emitter Voltage

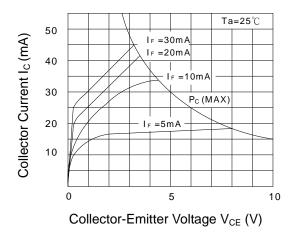
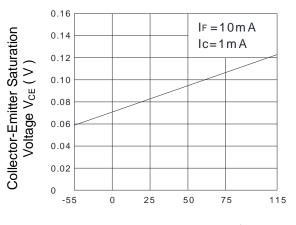


Fig.8 Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Ambient Temperature

Fig.10 Response Time (Rise) vs. Load Resistance

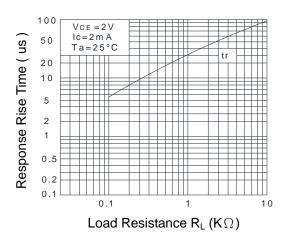
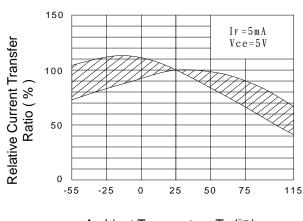
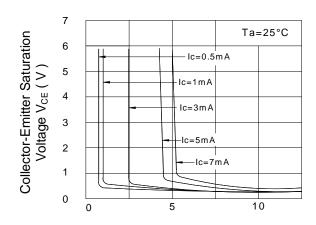


Fig.7 Relative Current Transfer Ratio vs. Ambient Temperature



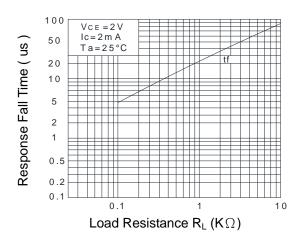

Forward Current I_F (mA)

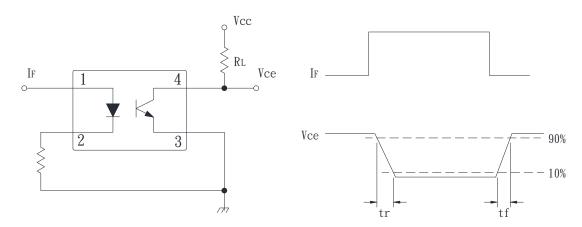
Fig.11 Response Time (Fall) vs. Load Resistance

Recommended Soldering Conditions

(a) Infrared reflow soldering:

■ Peak reflow soldering : 260°C or below (package surface temperature)

■ Time of peak reflow temperature : 10 sec
■ Time of temperature higher than 230°C : 30-60 sec
■ Time to preheat temperature from 180~190°C : 60-120 sec

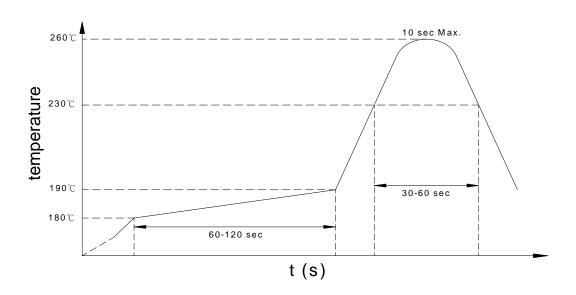
■ Time(s) of reflow: Two

■ Flux : Rosin flux containing small amount of chlorine (The

flux with a maximum chlorine content of 0.2 Wt% is

recommended.)

(b) Wave soldering:

■ Temperature : 260°C or below (molten solder temperature)

■ Time : 10 seconds or less

■ Preheating conditions : 120°C or below (package surface temperature)

■ Time(s) of reflow : One

■ Flux: Rosin flux containing small amount of chlorine (The flux with a maximum

chlorine content of 0.2 Wt% is recommended.)

(c) Cautions:

■ Fluxes : Avoid removing the residual flux with freon-based and chlorine-based

cleaning solvent.

Avoid shorting between portion of frame and leads.

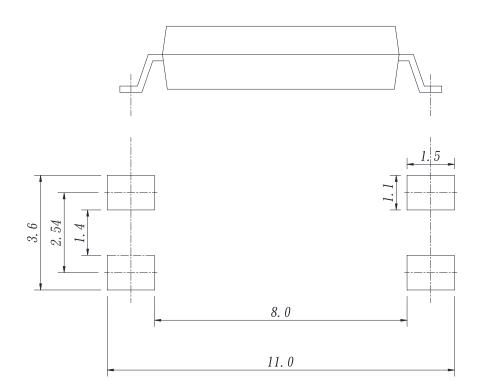

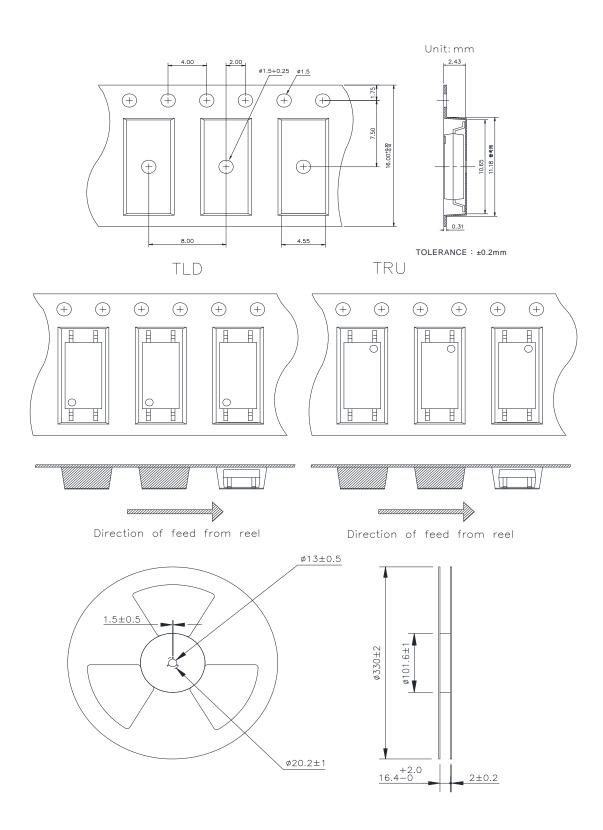
• Recommended Pad Layout for Surface Mount Lead Form
